RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA’S DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE 2022 REBUILDING AMERICA’S INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND EQUITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Rebuilding America’s Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) program aims to make transportation systems safer, more accessible, and more sustainable; and

WHEREAS, the RAISE program was allocated \$1.5 billion in grant funding to help communities around the country carry out projects with significant local or regional impact; and

WHEREAS, Cottage Grove is an eligible recipient for 2022 RAISE funds; and

WHEREAS, Cottage Grove is proposing to submit a grant application as part of the 2022 RAISE Program for the following project:

1. County Road 19A/100th Street realignment between Innovation Road and Jamaica Avenue

WHEREAS, the project will be of mutual benefit to Washington County, and the City of Cottage Grove as well the public traveling throughout the area; and

WHEREAS, Washington County is committed to providing the county share of the costs if this project is selected as part of the 2022 RAISE program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Washington County supports the application submitted by the City of Cottage Grove seeking funding from the federal government through the 2022 RAISE program and the county is committed to completing the project identified above and providing the county share of funding.
