

Granada Avenue Water Main Extension

Project Update

6/4/20

Project recap 6/1 to 6/5

- Grinding of the pavement took place on 71st Street (north half) and Granada Ave. (west half) down to the north side of the Granada Alcove intersection.
- Approximately 1500 feet of water main was installed starting at the Granada Ave. and 71st Street intersection and heading west and south along Granada Avenue.

Proposed Work Schedule for 6/8 to 6/12

- The contractor plans to start the jacking of water main underground from the north to the south under the 70th Street and Granada Avenue intersection on Monday, June 8. This work requires the contractor to occupy the north bound entrance lane of the northern Pine Summit neighborhood on Granada Avenue. For the duration of this work, there will be a temporary detour set up for people entering that neighborhood to be re-routed to Meadow Grass Avenue for access from 70th Street.
- The east lane of Granada Avenue between 70th Street and 71st Street will be grinded up to a gravel surface. Water main will then be installed under this lane.
- Water Service Drillers will be on site beginning on Monday, June 8 to begin drilling water service piping into homes that we have contacted and have scheduled. We will keep reaching out to home owners as the project moves along to schedule a day for service drilling work. This is only for residents who have signed water service agreements with the City.
